BEIA Dues Collection

The Bloomfield Estates Improvement Association is the official name of the neighborhood organization. The BEIA represents the home and property owners of the subdivision. Our goal is to preserve and maintain the quality and beauty of the neighborhood and to defend the deed restrictions as established in our Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws.

Dues are collected from each homeowner and vacant land owner within the subdivision boundaries. The dues are used toward: the maintenance of common areas (pond, pillars, shared wetland and wooded areas), the legal fees to defend our deed restrictions, postage and supplies, web server fees, post office box rental, public storage, and the annual picnic.

Dues for home/property owners is **\$300**. Dues are paid annually and are due on **April 30th**. You have received a notice and an envelope for payment along with this newsletter.



Considering Changes to Your Property?

If you plan to build a new structure, or change an existing structure, your plans need to be submitted to the BEIA for approval **before** they are submitted to the Township.

Please review, and abide by, the requirements listed in the BEIA Deed and Building Restrictions. Note that the requirements vary by lot number. Detailed information can be found at: http://bloomfieldestates.org/deed-restrictions/
