### **Talking Trash**

If you are inclined to be generous with the people who solicit at the corner of Big Beaver and Woodward, please circle-back an hour later to pick up the garbage left behind. We collected 5 bags of (mostly) food trash and several bags of recycled debris left behind. This type of garbage is attracting animal attention, including rats and raccoons that will find their way into our neighborhood.



Bloomfield Township Open Storage Ordinance prohibits storing man-made items in public view including wheel barrows and garbage cans. The Noxious Weed Ordinance prohibits grass/weeds that reach a height of 8". Residents dumping lawn debris in public areas is not permitted. Township officials can authorize removal/bill against homeowners property tax.
